#### Summer 2024

### **Reception Only Entrance**

From September, the Reception entrance will be just for our Reception parents and children to use. The second gate will not be open on a morning or evening. This is so that we can set up and put all of the Early Years equipment out and leave it for the children each day, without having to move things aside to create a pathway for parents each morning and evening. Parents and children from Year 1 to Year 4 will need to turn right as they come up the front school path and walk round to their door. Alternatively, you can enter the school via the side gate close to Bankfields Road.

#### **Summer Fair**

Thank you to everyone who came along to support our Summer Fair. We have added this money to the Easter Bingo funds and have raised an incredible £2154.24. This is an amazing achievement and we are so grateful to you all for your ongoing support. We are going to use this funding to support our planned development of sports and active time across school, as well as enhancing break and lunchtimes. Our aim is to develop our approaches at break time so that we have a range of activities for all children to enjoy. This will ensure that our breaks not only give children the opportunity to be active, but to offer a variety of interesting activities to suit the children's needs. We know that not all children are interested in the same things, so want our children's free time to be as exciting and rewarding as possible. Any remaining fundraising money will be used to subsidise the experiences we offer the children throughout the year including trips and visitors.





# Reminder - Extension of the School Day

Just a reminder of the timings of our school day from September will be 8:50am - 3:20pm from September 2024, with doors opening from 8:40am. Please can we ask all parents and carers to ensure that their children are in school at 8:40am ready to start their lessons promptly at 8:50am. We have lots of interventions in place that start as soon as the children come into school, so it is vital that your child does not miss out on these and key inputs from their teachers.

#### **Creating Active Schools**

We are incredibly excited to have been accepted to be part of the Creating Active Schools project in collaboration with the School Sports Partnership next year. This is an amazing opportunity for us to work with the Sports Partnership and to access additional funding to enhance our sports provision across school further. This is something that we are passionate about at Bankfields as we believe that children can only learn best when they have lots of opportunities to be active too. This not only supports their physical but their mental wellbeing. We will be exploring further ways in which the children can be active during the school day which will also give the children the opportunity to explore new sports and games that they may never have tried before. Our after-school clubs will continue as they have this year and we encourage as many children as possible to sign up and try something new!

#### **PE Kits**

Next year, children will be able to continue to come into school on their allocated PE day wearing their PE kits. You will receive information from your child's teacher in September to inform you of when their PE day will be each week. We encourage all children to wear the PE kit which is set out in our School Prospectus and consists of:

- Royal blue t-shirt (with or without the school logo)
- Royal blue or navy shorts (or jogging bottoms in colder weather)
- Plimsolls or trainers.
- Children may also wear a PE Hoody (on PE days ONLY)
   which can be purchased from our uniform provider, Lollipops.
