We're excited to announce that the first of our new OPAL Play Zones will be opening after Christmas so that the children will be able to enjoy playing together across year groups each lunch time. Thank you to all parents and carers who completed our play survey. We have tried to incorporate lots of your suggestions about how we can improve playtimes for your children. The new play zones that will open after Christmas include:

- A brand new mud kitchen aprons includ-
- A wheels zone (where children can use scooters and go-karts).
- A balance and movement zone where children will have access to skips, space hoppers, sit on scooters, ankle skips, the bars and much more.
- A ball games zone where the children can continue to play football and basketball, even in the winter months.
